

During the month of October 2025, there were fifty-eight outbreaks reported in West Virginia and all were confirmed to be outbreaks or clusters of disease. Reported settings included 11 long-term care facilities (LTCF), 3 assisted living facilities, 26 schools, 13 daycares, 2 community based, 2 in food and hospitality and 1 in other healthcare setting.

The rest of this report describes the types and settings of the outbreaks. All data provided is provisional as some outbreaks may still be under investigation.

Figure 1 illustrates confirmed outbreaks by type.






Figure 2 illustrates the number of outbreaks per region by type.




Figure 3 displays the number of outbreaks by region.







Figure 4 displays the number of outbreaks by type and month for the period from 2024 to 2025.
