West Virginia Harm Reduction Programs At-A-Glance

Certified vs. Non-Certified:

Harm Reduction Programs (HRPs) have been operating in West Virginia since 2011, providing sterile syringes, collecting non-sterile (used) syringes, and acting as points of access to prevention, testing and treatment for blood-borne diseases as well as providing family planning and referrals to medical treatment and social services.

<u>The Harm Reduction Program Guidelines and Certification Procedures</u> by the West Virginia Department of Health and Human Resources (WV DHHR), Bureau for Public Health (revised August 27, 2018) outline the minimum requirements for West Virginia HRPs to receive funding through WV DHHR.

Certification is not a requirement for HRPs to operate in West Virginia. However, it does ensure HRPs follow core guidelines essential to successful program implementation.

Transaction Model:

- <u>One for One</u>: For every non-sterile syringe returned, the participant receives a sterile syringe.
- <u>One for One Plus</u>: For every non-sterile syringe returned, it is possible for the participant to receive more than one sterile syringe. Number is pre-defined by program policy. Typically, there is still some requirement that participants turn in non-sterile syringes to receive sterile ones; however, there is more flexibility when participants do not have enough, or possible any, non-sterile syringes to exchange
- <u>Needs-Based</u>: no limit on the number of syringes a participant may receive regardless of the number of non-sterile syringes returned. Participants are encouraged but not required to return non-sterile syringes to receive sterile ones. Number dispensed is determined by reported usage. There may or may not be a set limit on number of syringes dispensed per transaction.

Service Delivery Method:

- <u>Fixed Site</u>: Harm reduction services provided at a fixed location, such as a local health department or health clinics
- <u>Mobile Delivery</u>: Syringe exchange is conducted using a van. Stops are made at designated locations at specific times. Mobile routes typically require pre-approval and authorization from community stakeholders
- <u>Both</u>: Fixed site also provides mobile delivery services
