Reporting HIV

What to Report: Positive HIV screens w/reflex to HIV confirmatory test and HIV-1 RNA/DNA NAAT (Viral Loads)

When To Report: Within seven days

How To Report: By mail or secure fax

Reporting Gonorrhea, Chlamydia, and Syphilis

What to Report: Gonorrhea (GC)/chlamydia (CT) NAAT or RPR w/reflex to titer and confirmatory, **or** treponemal test with reflex to RPR w/titer and confirmatory

When To Report: Within seven days (24 hours for congenital syphilis)

How To Report: By secure fax

Reporting Hepatitis A, B, C, D, and E

What to Report: Positive hepatitis A, B, C, D, and E labs with liver function and bilirubin levels if done

When To Report: Within 24 hours for A, B, D, and E labs and within 1 week for hepatitis C labs

How To Report: Contact Local Health Department for positive hepatitis A, B, D, and E labs, and contact State Health Department for positive hepatitis C labs
