If participation in the VFC Program has become unnecessary or undesirable, please follow these guidelines to inactivate your practice.

- Immediately notify the Division of Immu nization Services of your decision by calling: 1-800-642-3634 or (304) 558-2188.
- 2. Instructions for transferring the remaining VFC vaccine will be provided at the time of your call.
- 3. Submit a **written request for inactivation** (signed by the physician) along with the following reports:
  - West Virginia Vaccine On Hand Report document remaining VFC vaccine stock (including expiration dates and lot numbers)
  - The temperature log
  - Vaccine Incident Report if you have expired vaccine
