

West Virginia Animal Rabies Surveillance Report



JANUARY 1 – JULY 10, 2026

The purpose of this report is to share descriptive surveillance data related to animal rabies activity with public health partners in West Virginia. Office of Laboratory Services (OLS) and United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Data:

During the period of January 1 to July 10, 2026, 28 animals tested positive for rabies at OLS. USDA has had three rabies positive animal in 2026 (raccoons from Ohio County and Randolph County), but their data is only accurate up to May 31, 2026 (Tables 1 and 2).

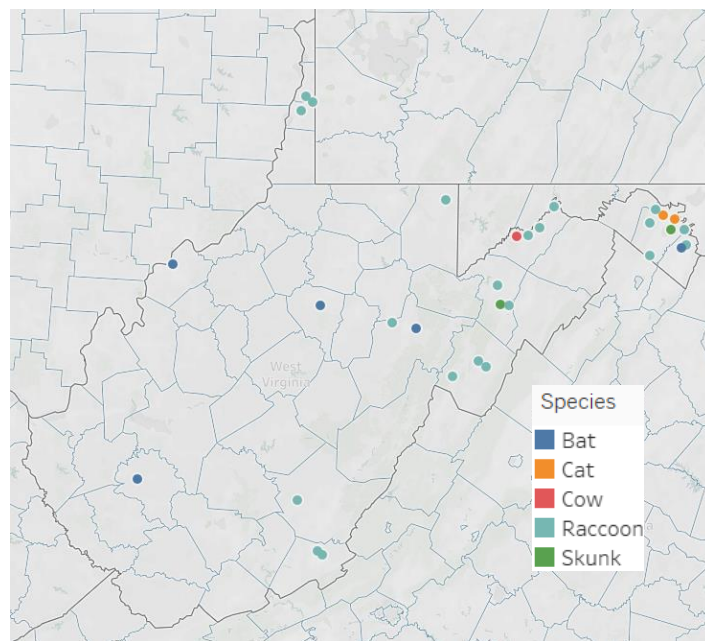


Figure 1. Map of rabies positive animals tested at OLS and USDA through 7/10/26.
