

West Virginia Animal Rabies Surveillance Report



JANUARY 1 – AUGUST 6, 2026

The purpose of this report is to share descriptive surveillance data related to animal rabies activity with public health partners in West Virginia. Office of Laboratory Services (OLS) and United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Data:

During the period of January 1 to August 6, 2026, 32 animals tested positive for rabies at OLS. USDA had four rabies positive animal in 2026 (two raccoons from Brooke County and one each in Ohio County and Randolph County), but their data is only accurate up to June 30, 2026 (Tables 1 and 2).

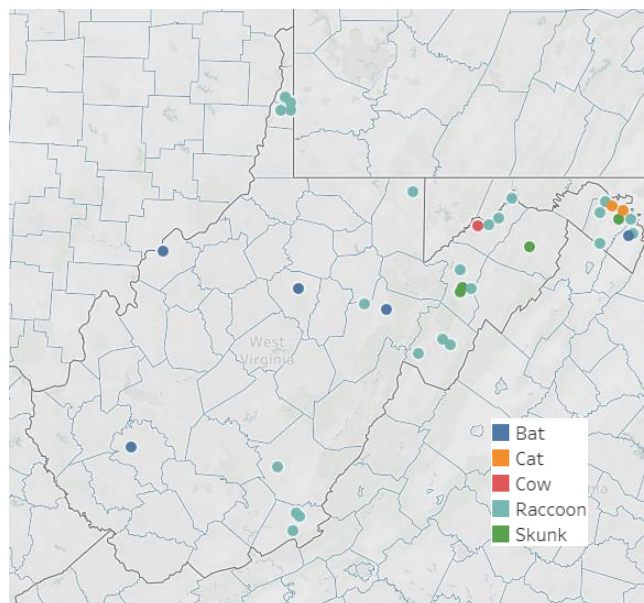


Figure 1. Map of rabies positive animals tested at OLS and USDA through 8/6/26.
