Outbreak Report for January 2018 West Virginia



During the month of January 2018, there were 94 outbreaks reported in West Virginia. Of the 94 outbreaks reported, 91 (97%) were confirmed as outbreaks or clusters of disease and three were investigated and determined not to be outbreaks. Seventy-five were reported from healthcare facilities, eight from schools, four from daycares, one from a residential facility, and three outbreaks involved multiple schools in the same county and were classified as community outbreaks.

Seventy (93%) healthcare-associated outbreaks were reported from long-term care facilities (LTCFs), two from assisted living facilities (ALFs), two from hospitals, and one from a rehabilitation facility.

The rest of this report describes the types and settings of the outbreaks. All data provided is provisional.




