# **Outbreak Report for March 2018 West Virginia**



During the month of March 2018, there were 27 outbreaks reported in West Virginia. Of the 27 outbreaks reported, 24 (89%) were confirmed as outbreaks or clusters of disease and three were investigated and determined not to be outbreaks. Sixteen were reported from healthcare facilities, four from schools, three from communities, and one was part of a multi-state outbreak.

Fourteen (88%) healthcare-associated outbreaks were reported from long-term care facilities (LTCFs), one from an assisted living facility (ALF), and one from a rehabilitation facility.

The rest of this report describes the types and settings of the outbreaks. All data provided is provisional.





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
