Outbreak Report for October 2018 West Virginia



During the month of October 2018, there were 13 outbreaks reported in West Virginia. Twelve (92%) were confirmed as outbreaks or clusters of disease and the remaining one was investigated and determined not to be an outbreak. Five were reported from healthcare facilities, four from daycares, two from schools, and one from a workplace involving residents of multiple states.

Of the five healthcare-associated outbreaks, four (80%) were reported from long-term care facilities (LTCF) and is part of a multi-state outbreak in an out-of-state outpatient clinic.

The rest of this report describes the types and settings of the outbreaks. All data provided is provisional.






