Outbreak Report for September 2018 West Virginia



During the month of September 2018, there were 16 outbreaks reported in West Virginia. All reported outbreaks were confirmed as outbreaks or clusters of disease. Six were reported from healthcare facilities, four from schools, four from daycares, one from a sports team, and one is part of a multi-state outbreak.

Of the six healthcare-associated outbreaks, five were reported from long-term care facilities (LTCF) and one from an Assisted Living Facility (ALF).

The rest of this report describes the types and settings of the outbreaks. All data provided is provisional.






