Outbreak Report for January 2019 West Virginia



During the month of January 2019, there were 43 outbreaks reported in West Virginia. Forty (93%) were confirmed as outbreaks or clusters of disease, two were determined not to be outbreaks and one is under ongoing investigation. Twenty-six (68%) were reported from healthcare facilities, eight from schools, three from daycares, one from a community, and two are part of multi-state investigations.

Of the 26 healthcare-associated outbreaks, 22 (85%) were reported from long-term care facilities (LTCF), three from hospitals, and one from a rehabilitation facility.

The rest of this report describes the types and settings of the outbreaks. All data provided is provisional.




