This agency has responsibilities for protecting the public's health or safety pursuant to W. Va. Code R. § 64-7 to investigate or obtain information for the purposes set forth in and authorized by the cited Statute.

As the authorized head of this agency or delegated representative, I hereby request the following Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) Medical Centers within VISN 4 to report patient health information pursuant to the West Virginia Reportable Disease Legislative Rule (W. Va. Code R. § 64-7) regarding the reporting of infectious disease information and any other information that the department requires by regulation.

- Department of Veteran's Affairs Medical Center, Wilkes-Barre, PA, and all associated community-based clinics
- Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Center, Wilmington, DE, and all associated community-based clinics

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This information will not be utilized for any purpose other than required by law. This agency is aware of the penalty provisions of 38 U.S.C. §5701(f)(2) which provides a penalty for unauthorized use of names or addresses of Veterans and their dependents not to exceed \$5,000 for the first offense and \$20,000 for any subsequent offense. This request shall be valid for a period of three years.
