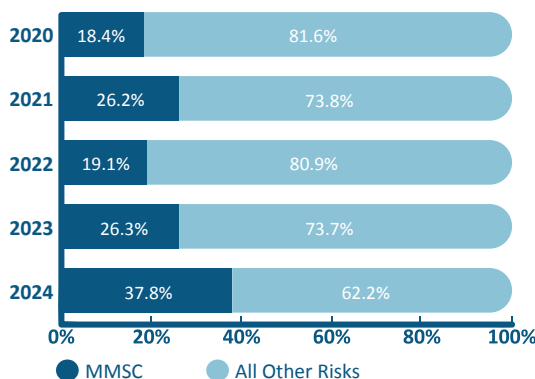


HIV Attributed to Male-to-Male Sexual Contact in West Virginia

2024

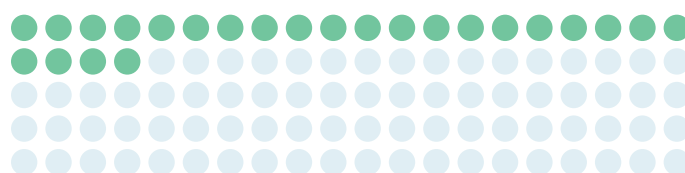
In 2024, there were **34** new diagnoses of HIV attributed to male-to-sexual contact (MMSC), including MMSC and injection drug use (IDU).

Newly Diagnosed HIV by Transmission Category, 2020-2024



From 2020 to 2024, the number of newly diagnosed HIV cases attributed to MMSC increased by **36%**.

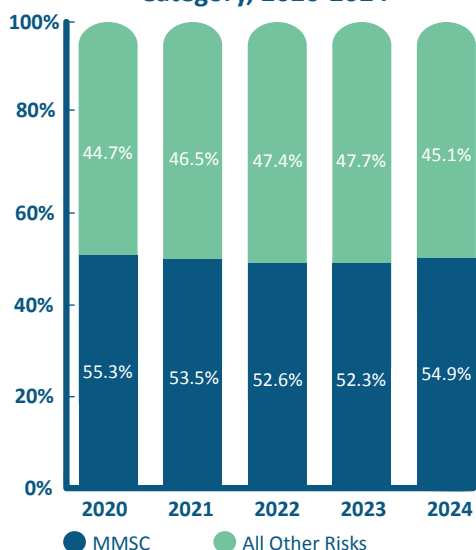
23.5% of newly diagnosed HIV attributed to MMSC were diagnosed late at Stage 3 HIV (AIDS).



Persons Living With HIV

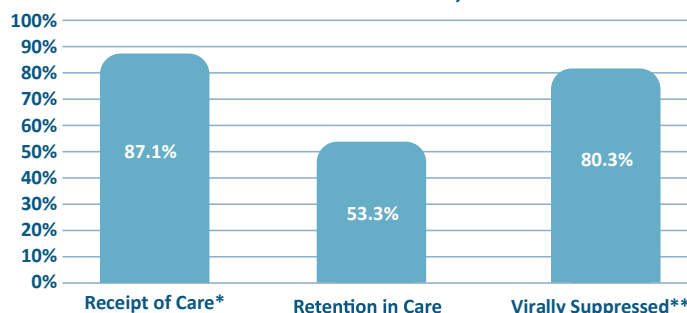
In 2024, there were **1,243** persons living with diagnosed HIV attributed to MMSC, including MMSC and IDU.

Persons Living with HIV by Transmission Category, 2020-2024



31.4% of persons living with HIV attributed to MMSC were between the ages of 55-64.

HIV Care Continuum, 2024



*Receipt of care was measured by documentation of ≥ 1 CD4 or VL test during the calendar year. Retention in care was measured by documentation of ≥ 2 CD4 or VL test at least 3 months apart in the calendar year.

**A VL test result of < 200 copies/mL indicates HIV viral suppression.
