RE: STANDING ORDERS FOR SPUTUM COLLECTION FOR TB TESTING

TO: All WV Local Health Departments

ORDERS:

1. Submit all specimens to WV Office of Laboratory Services (OLS). Time mailings so they don't arrive on a holiday or weekend.
2. Use the procedure shown on our website for the correct process of collecting specimens at:
[https://oepls.wv.gov/tuberculosis/documents/lhd/AFB Patient Collection Instructions.pdf](https://oepls.wv.gov/tuberculosis/documents/lhd/AFB_Patient_Collection_Instructions.pdf).
3. For any suspect case of TB, obtain 3 consecutive days morning sputum for smear and culture.
4. For all active TB cases:
 - Obtain initial 3 consecutive days morning sputum for smear and culture.
 - Then obtain 3 consecutive days morning sputum two weeks after the start of treatment.
 - Then obtain 3 consecutive days morning sputum every two weeks until all three consecutive smears are negative.
 - Then obtain 3 consecutive days morning sputum monthly until all 3 culture results are negative for two months.
5. Follow the above criteria unless otherwise instructed by clinician.
