

Reported Cases of Hepatitis A, by Year of Onset, West Virginia, 1999-2008, (N=227)




The increase in incidence from 1999 through 2002 is due to changes in disease surveillance practices.

The high number of cases in 2003 is attributed to a multi state outbreak.


Reported Cases of Hepatitis A, by Month of Onset, West Virginia, 1999-2008, (N=227)
