HEALTH ADVISORY #189 Change in COVID-19 Treatments and Locations

TO: West Virginia Healthcare Providers, Hospitals and Other Healthcare Facilities

On January 24, 2022, the US Food and Drug Administration (FDA) determined that the monoclonal antibody treatments for COVID-19 *casirivimab plus imdevimab (Regeneron) and bamlanivimab plus etesevimab may no longer be used in any US jurisdiction* due to being ineffective against the Omicron variant, which is the predominant variant circulating in West Virginia at this time. The Bureau for Public Health is providing this advisory to make providers aware, that while those two treatments are no longer available, alternative treatments are available which include the monoclonal antibody sotrovimab (infusion) and the antivirals paxlovid (oral), molnupiravir (oral), and remdesivir (infusion). The available treatments remain in extremely limited supply.

Therapy determinations and selection should be made following the National Institutes of Health Guidelines for Prioritization, including:

- **Tier 1:** Immunocompromised individuals not expected to mount an adequate immune response due to their underlying condition, regardless of vaccination status. Unvaccinated individuals at the highest risk of severe disease (anyone aged ≥75 years or anyone aged ≥65 years with additional risk factors).
- **Tier 2:** Unvaccinated individuals at risk of severe disease not included in Tier 1 (anyone aged ≥65 years or anyone aged <65 years with clinical risk factors).
- **Tier 3:** Vaccinated individuals at high risk of severe disease (anyone aged ≥75 years or anyone aged ≥65 years with clinical risk factors). Vaccinated individuals who have not received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose are likely at higher risk for severe disease; patients in this situation within this tier should be prioritized for treatment.
- **Tier 4:** Vaccinated individuals at risk of severe disease (anyone aged ≥65 years or anyone aged <65 with clinical risk factors). Vaccinated individuals who have not received a COVID-19 vaccine booster dose are likely at higher risk for severe disease; patients in this situation within this tier should be prioritized for treatment.

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This message was directly distributed by the West Virginia Bureau for Public Health to local health departments and professional associations. Receiving entities are responsible for further disseminating the information as appropriate to the target audience.

Categories of Health Alert messages:

Health Alert: Conveys the highest level of importance. Warrants immediate action or attention.

Health Advisory: Provides important information for a specific incident or situation. May not require immediate action.

The locations of pharmacies that have been provided supplies of paxlovid and molnupiravir are attached (See Appendix). West Virginia receives a limited allocation every two weeks that is geographically spread throughout the state.

Please note that any of the available treatments for COVID-19 are not a substitute for vaccination in individuals for whom COVID-19 vaccination (including a booster dose) is recommended. COVID-19 vaccination remains the strongest, most effective, and most readily available tool to protect against the virus.

Locations Carrying Oral Antiviral Treatments for COVID-19 by Prescription

Medication quantity is extremely limited. Prescribers must provide the patient's COVID-19 positive test result via PCR or Antigen (PCR preferred). The prescription will not be filled without the positive test result within a 5-day range (medication for qualifying patients should be started as soon as possible after confirmed diagnosis, no later than 5 days after onset of symptoms).
